- ☑ AHEC Health Professions Summer Academy Application including a 300-word typewritten essay.

- ☑ **Two** completed teacher evaluation forms. AHEC will only accept evaluations from science, mathematics or health instructors. At least one evaluation must be from a science or health instructor.
- ☑ Official high school transcript: Grades 9-10 for rising juniors and Grades 9-11 for rising seniors
- ☑ All completed applications must be mailed by the applicant or parent.

About the Academy

The USF AHEC Health Professions Summer Academy is a two-week residential academic program intended to increase the college preparation skills of high school students interested in health professions careers such as: medicine, dentistry, nursing, pharmacy, physical therapy, allied health and public health. Students will be introduced to USF faculty in the Colleges of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Public Health, Arts and Sciences, and the School of Physical Therapy. Professionals from health careers in dentistry and allied health will also provide college preparation information for students participating in the Academy.

The Academy strongly encourages enrollment of students from groups underrepresented in the health professions. Those groups include:

- ☑ African American/Black
- ☑ Mexican American or Puerto Rican
- ☑ Native American/Alaskan Native
- ☑ Low-income, first generation college students



Eligibility

Students will be selected from a highly competitive pool of applicants. Only students who meet the following criteria are eligible for the Academy.

- ☑ Students entering their junior or senior year of high school
- ☑ Students who live in Charlotte, Citrus, DeSoto, Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas or Sarasota counties
- ☑ Students who have a 3.0 un-weighted GPA
- ☑ Students who are underrepresented in the health professions and/or disadvantaged (low-income, first generation college students)

Program Activities

During their two weeks in the program, students have an opportunity to engage in the following activities:

- ☑ Personal development workshops
- ☑ SAT/standardized test preparation course
- ☑ College admission and financial aid workshops
- ☑ USF college tours
- ☑ Hospital and clinic tours
- ☑ Other workshops and seminars

Benefits

Each student will receive a **scholarship** to cover all Academy costs including:

- ☑ Tuition
- ☑ Room and board
- ☑ SAT/standardized test preparation materials
- ☑ Workshops presented by USF faculty and staff
- ☑ Transportation

Responsibilities

Students must adhere to all rules throughout the two-week program. Failure to comply with rules will result in dismissal of the participant from the Academy.

- ☑ Students must attend all classroom and extracurricular activities
- ☑ Students will be unable to check-out for overnight or weekends at home, except for emergencies
- ☑ Only parents are authorized to visit participants. No other visitors including boyfriends or girlfriends are permitted
