Competency Based Goals & Objectives

Description:

Residents will evaluate and identify children and adults presenting with musculoskeletal disease. This rotation stresses the physical examination and operative approaches to musculoskeletal disease.

Resident role and expectations:

Residents on the hand service will function as an important member of the care team, assisting in clinical patient evaluation and surgical management under the direct supervision and guidance of the attending staff.

Objectives by the end of the rotation:

1. **Medical knowledge:** Obtain knowledge and comprehension of biopsies of the bone and soft tissue lesions, surgical remove benign, non-aggressive soft tissue tumors such as intramuscular lipoma and have an understanding of the surgical management of musculoskeletal disease.
2. **Patient care:** Obtain acumen in diagnosing, treatment, and reconstructive procedures for metastatic disease. Order and interpret (with the assistance of the radiologist) common diagnostic imaging procedures when evaluating and managing patients with orthopaedic conditions: plain radiographs, body MRI, CT scan, radionuclide bone scans.
3. **Interpersonal and Communication skills:** Demonstrate interpersonal skills and professionalism necessary to adequately diagnose and treat musculoskeletal disease. Demonstrate courtesy and timeliness with colleagues, patients, and ancillary staff.
4. **System-based practice:** Demonstrate and understand the multiple disciplinary nature of the delivery of cancer care and recognize the importance of effectively employing close interaction with other members of the team including the radiologist, pathologist, musculoskeletal oncologist, radiation therapists and other surgical specialties.
5. **Professionalism:** Demonstrate initiative in the needs of patients and professional staff, showing honesty, compassion, and respect for the patient issues both in terms of the medical diagnosis and the psychosocial ramifications.
6. **Practice-based learning:** Demonstrate self-improvement through a critique of their performance during presentation of M&M cases.
